WCCS will be joining in this project again this year. We are asking students and families to bring in items for these boxes. Some ideas are listed below and can be purchased by age category: 2-4, 5-9 or 10-14. Thank you for your help in this ministry.

Gift Suggestions:

School Supplies: pens, pencils & sharpeners, crayons or markers, stamps & ink pad sets, writing pads or paper, solar calculators, coloring & picture books, etc.

Toys: small cars, balls, dolls, stuffed animals, kazoos, harmonicas, yo-yos, jump ropes small Etch A sketch, toys that light up or make noise(with extra batteries), Slinky, etc.

Hygiene Items: toothbrush, toothpaste, mild bar soap (in a plastic bag), comb, washcloth, etc.

Other: T-shirts, socks, ball caps, sunglasses, hair clips, toy jewelry, watches, flashlights (with extra batteries).

A Personal Note: You may enclose a note to the child and a photo of yourself or your family. (If you include your name and address, the child may write back).

Do Not Include: Used or damaged items; war related items such as toy guns, knives, or military figures; chocolate or food; out-of-date candy; liquids or lotions; medications or vitamins; breakable items such as snow globes or glass containers; aerosol cans.
