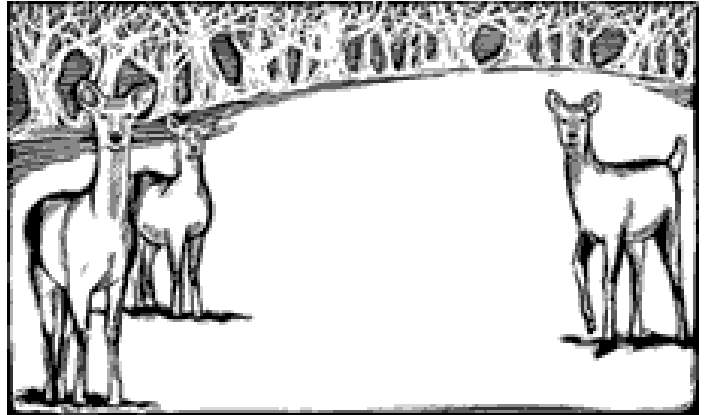
### *GoodSearch.com*
