Does Your Family Eat Crescent Rolls?

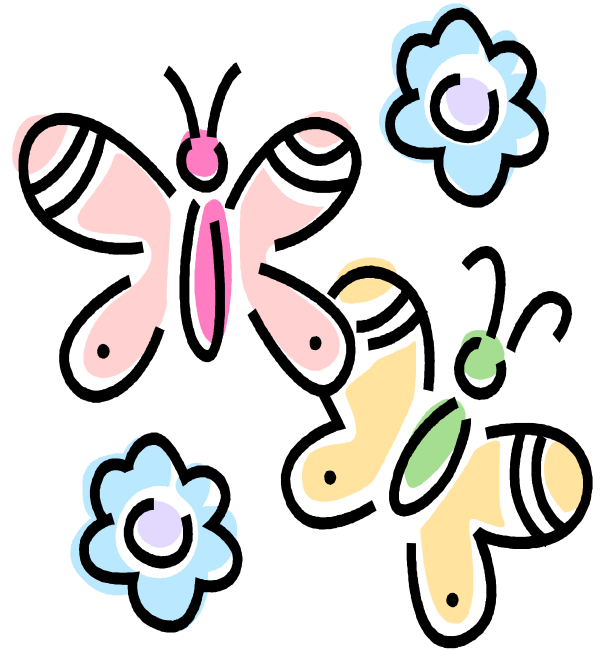

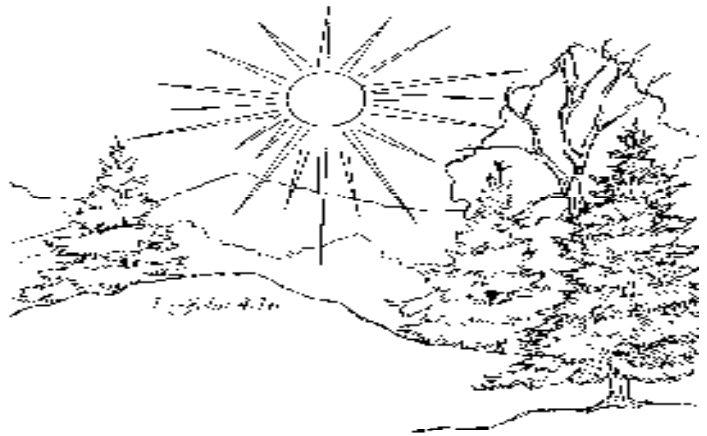

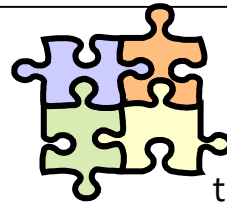
