EITC Facing Budget Cuts

PA's EITC program was cut by \$15 million in the 2009 state budget. There is talk of an additional \$10 million cut to this program in 2010. Limiting the available tax credit for businesses will limit the amount of scholarship dollars available for students across PA. **YOU CAN INFLUENCE THIS DECISION!!** Please contact your legislator in support of the EITC program. Go to: www.operationrestorepa.org. Once at the site:

1. Choose "Contact Your Legislator"
2. Type in your address and zip code, then click NEXT. The names of your legislators will display.
3. Choose the names of those to whom you wish to write. Click next
4. Choose one of the form letters or create your own. Fill in your information at the bottom of the page and click NEXT.

Here, you may edit your letter. Once you're satisfied, click the SEND button to finish.

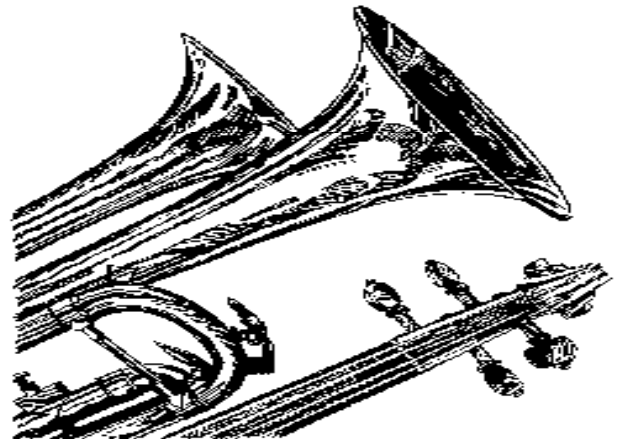

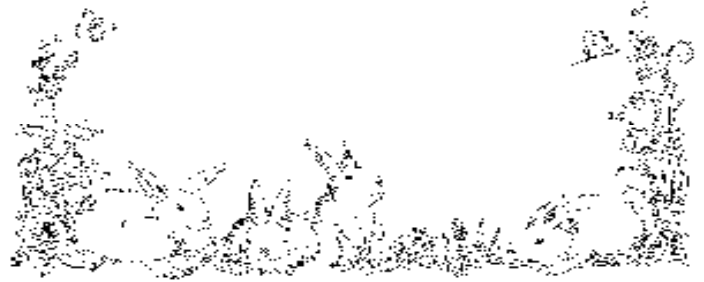

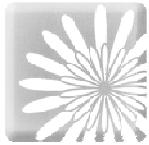

Tom Ridge Environmental Center

On Tuesday, April 27, all WCCS students will be going to the Tom Ridge Environmental Center (TREC). We will be leaving at 8:15AM and will return by 3:00PM in time for the buses.

Each child is asked to bring a sack lunch using disposable containers.

During the trip we will have time to enjoy interactive experiences at TREC as well as participate in outdoor environmental educational field experiences on Presque Isle. As the weather at Presque Isle is often different from surrounding areas, please dress your child accordingly. Warm layers with sturdy shoes is suggested.

Please note, as with most areas in NWPA, ticks are present at Presque Isle. The park staff will take preventative measures to avoid encounters during this trip; however it is recommended that your child wear light colored clothing with long pants and socks and bug spray to help in this effort.

While at TREC your child may be photographed or taped for use in exhibits and other material.

Also, do not forget to bring \$7.00 per student.
