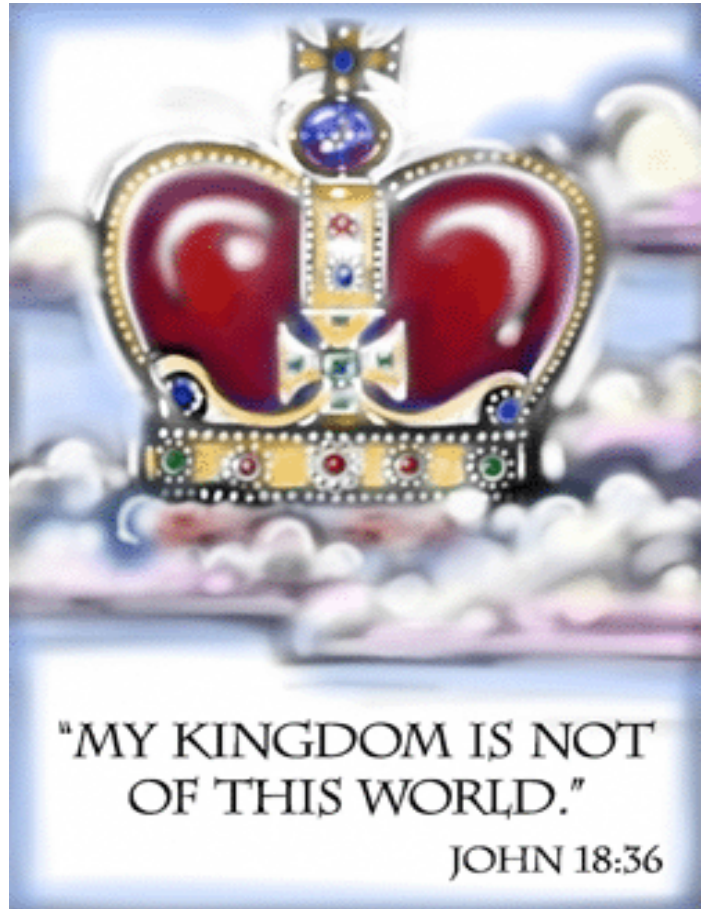
SERVATHON NOTE:
