



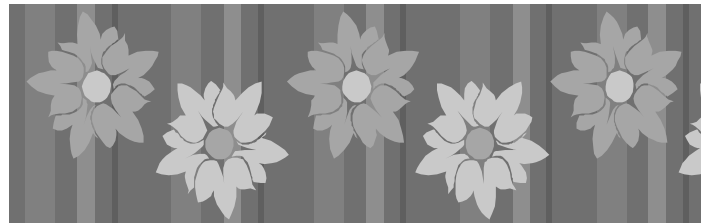

March minutes were approved.

The 2010-2011 budget was approved

Mrs. Beatty's temporary one year position was again approved for the 2010-2011 school year.

Student Accident Insurance: Since our liability insurance does not cover routine student accidents, further information is being gathered to assess the feasibility of offering it to parents who desire that option. The Board will look at amending the parent contract to clarify WCCS's responsibility concerning student accident insurance.

2010-2011 Calendar: A proposed 2010-2011 school calendar was presented at the meeting. The Board requested additional information.

Staffing applicants: The resumes of possible candidates to fill our 2010-2011 staffing needs have been received and reviewed by the board. Interviews are pending.

Language Requirements: A change to the WCCS Language requirement schedule was approved as follows: Students who desire to take Latin will take it in 9<sup>th</sup> and 10<sup>th</sup> grades. Students, who take Spanish, will do so in their Junior and Senior years.

Tech Grant: WCCS has received a Tech Grant Award through the Warren County School District. Additional information about the grant will be forthcoming.

Verizon Fundraiser: A fundraiser in which WCCS may receive donations when Verizon customers sign up for new services has been approved. Further details will be included in newsletters.

New Student: A kindergarten student was adopted into the school family for the new year.

Computer teacher: There was discussion about adding an extra day to the computer teacher's schedule to allow time for all the additional technical support that is required with the great expansion of our computer network and internet access throughout the building.
