This year, we'll be combining the fall party with a dedication/celebration for the playground and new annex rooms. Please stay tuned for further details!

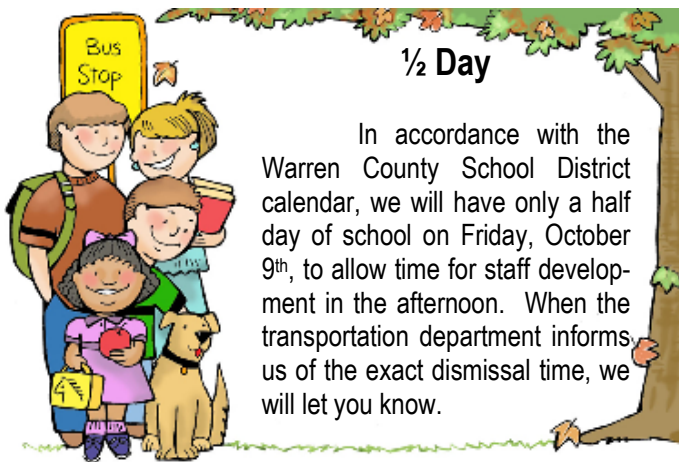


GRANDPARENTS' DAY
